cross-border labour market data

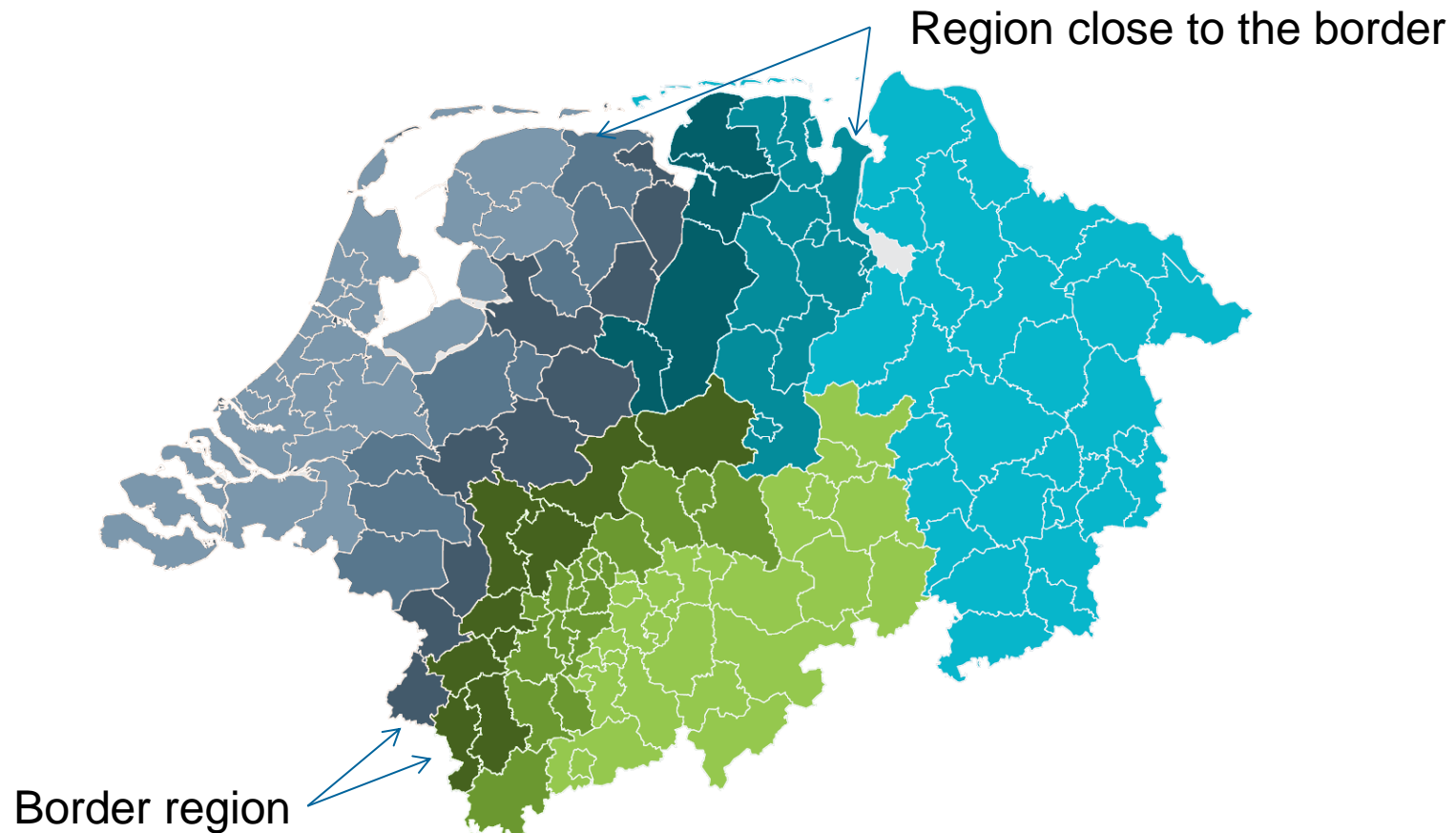


Labour market in border regions: The Netherlands-Germany

 - North Rhine-Westfalia

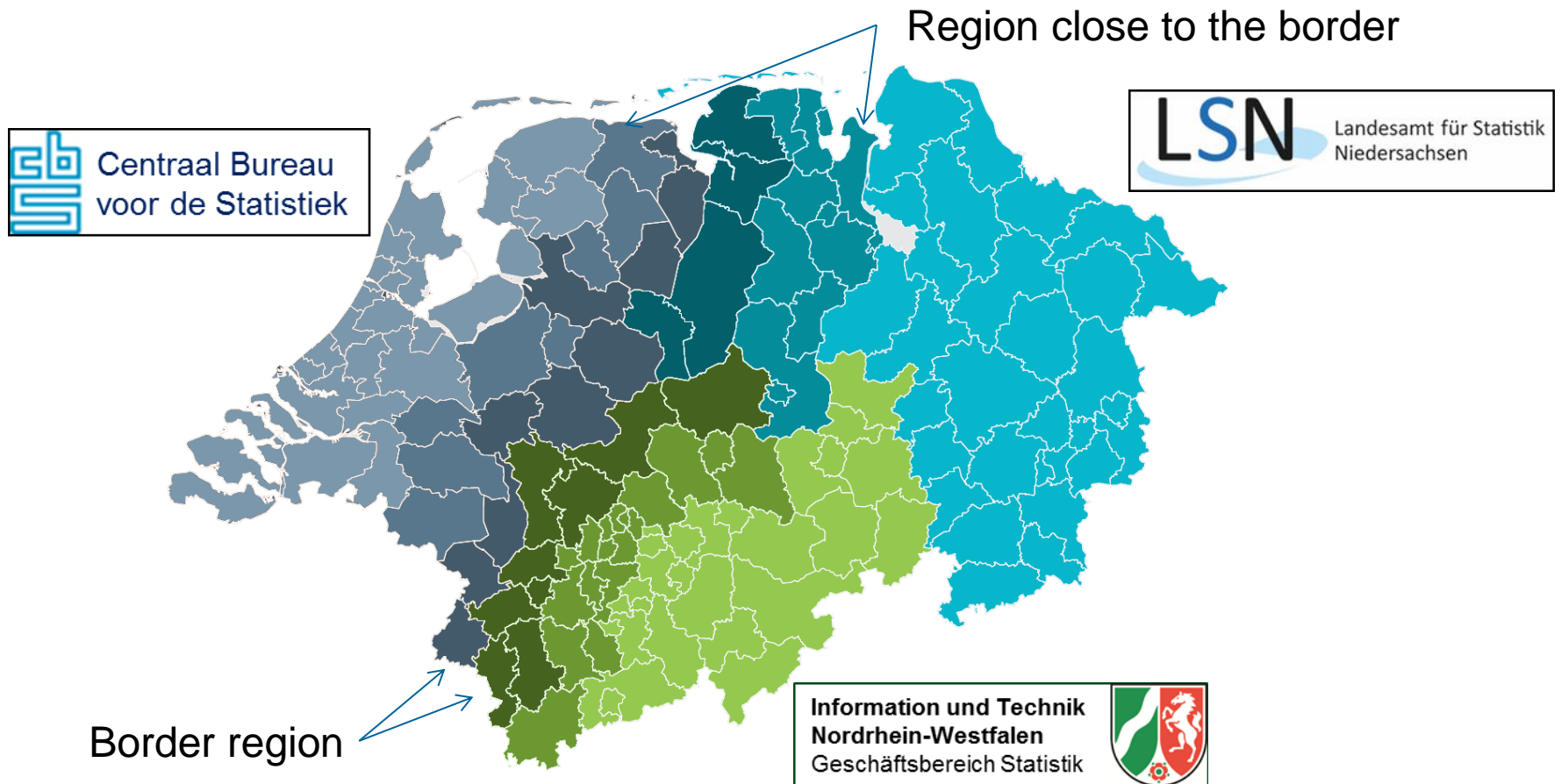

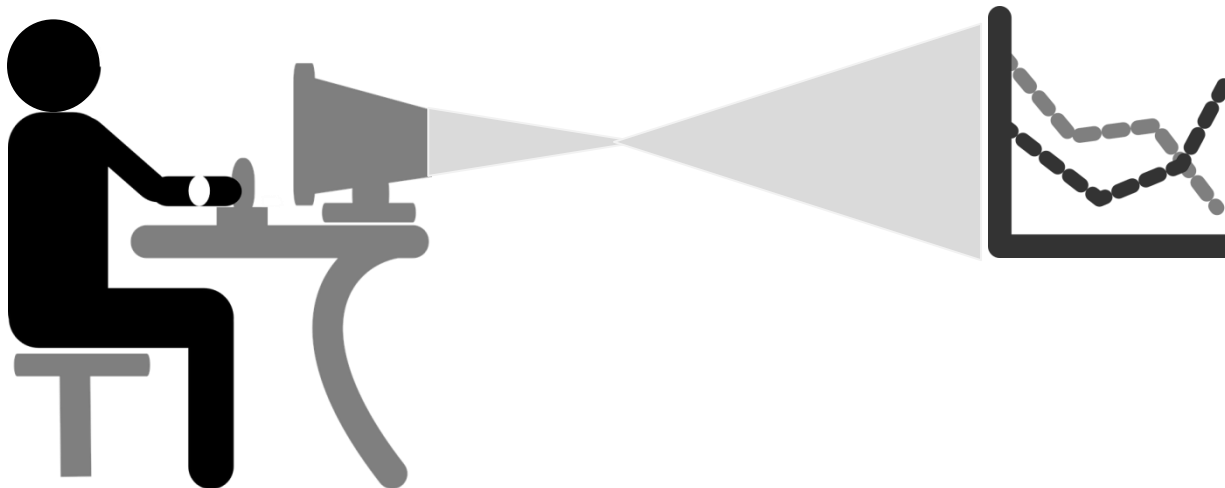

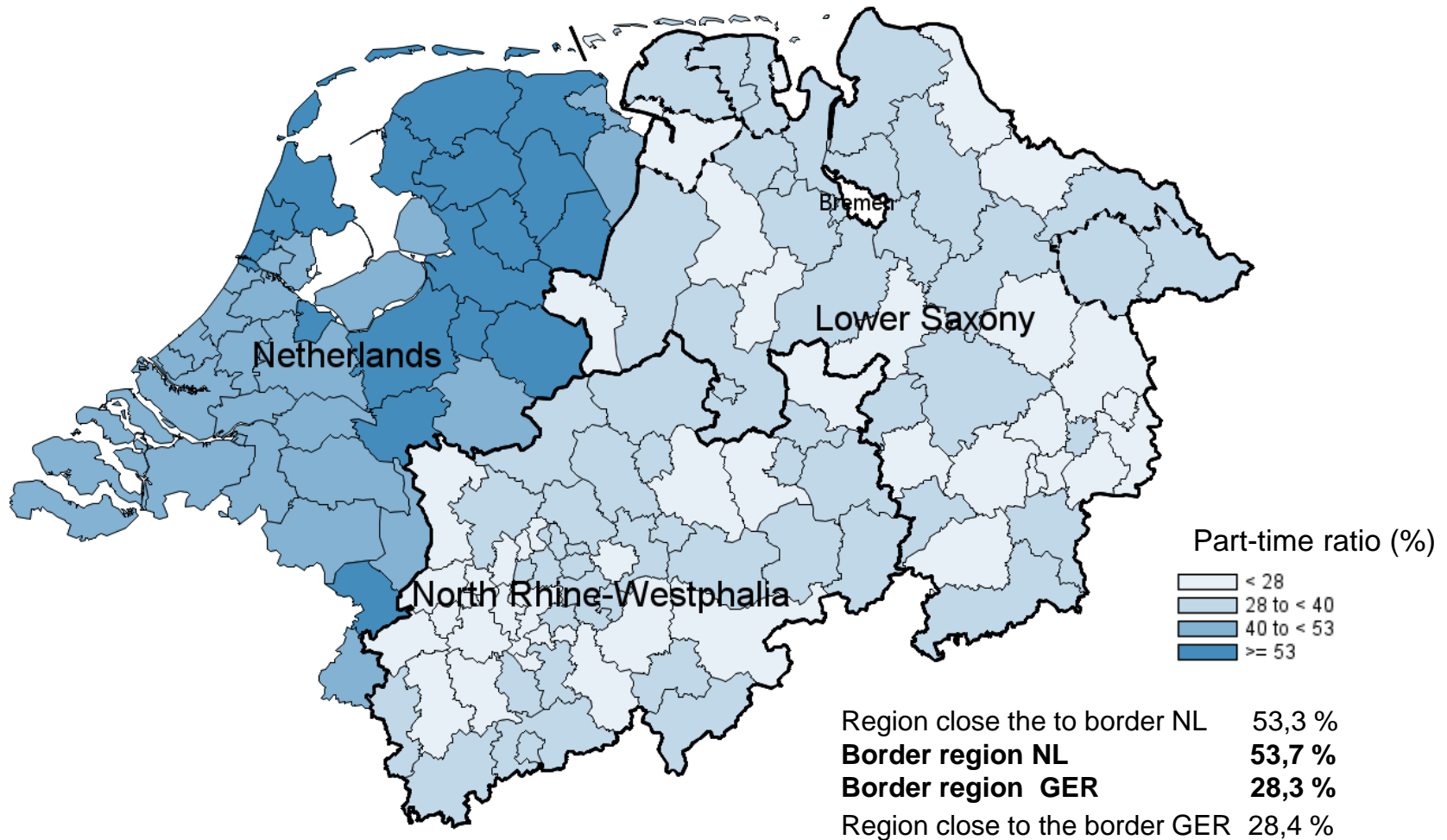

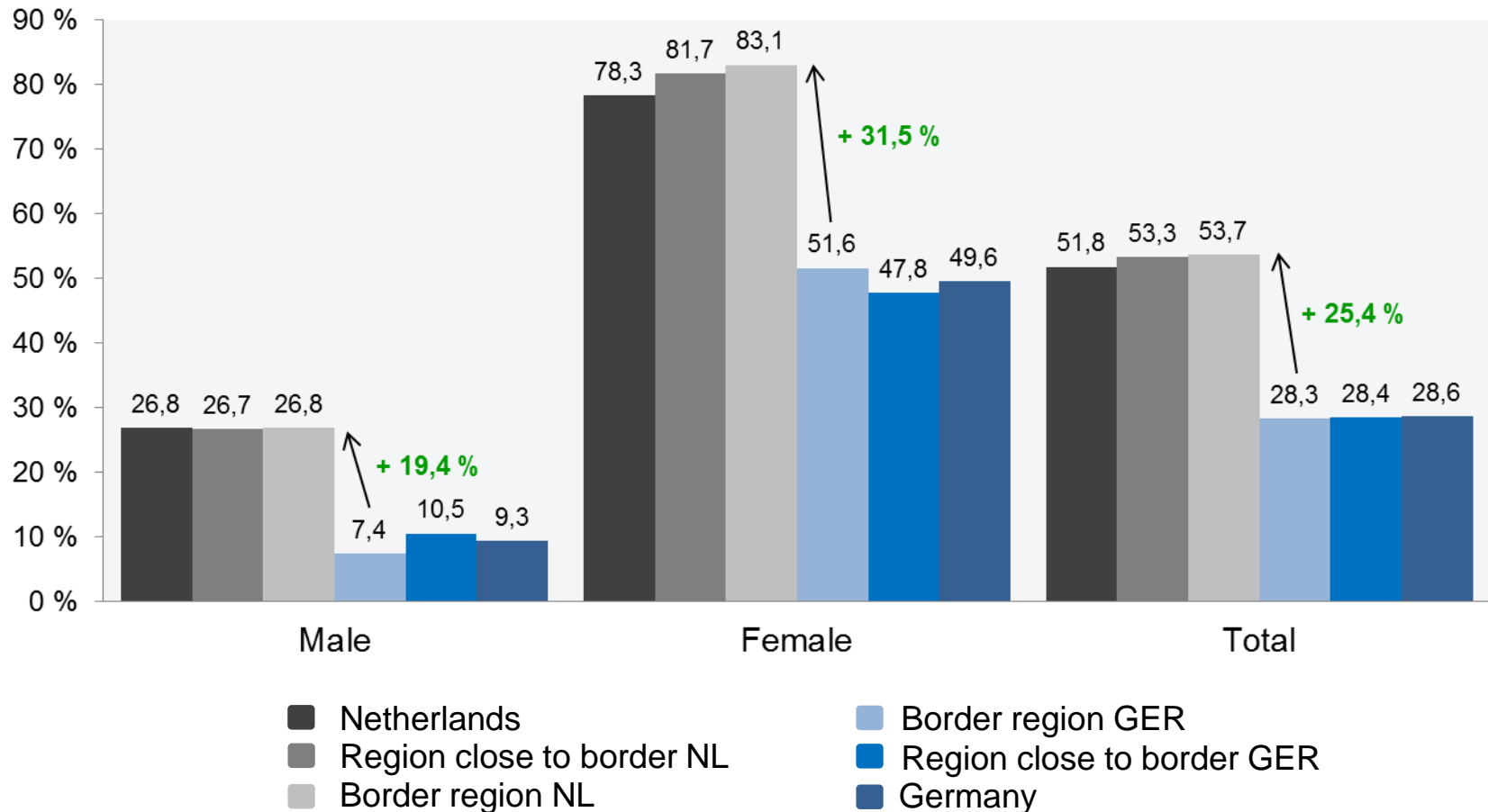

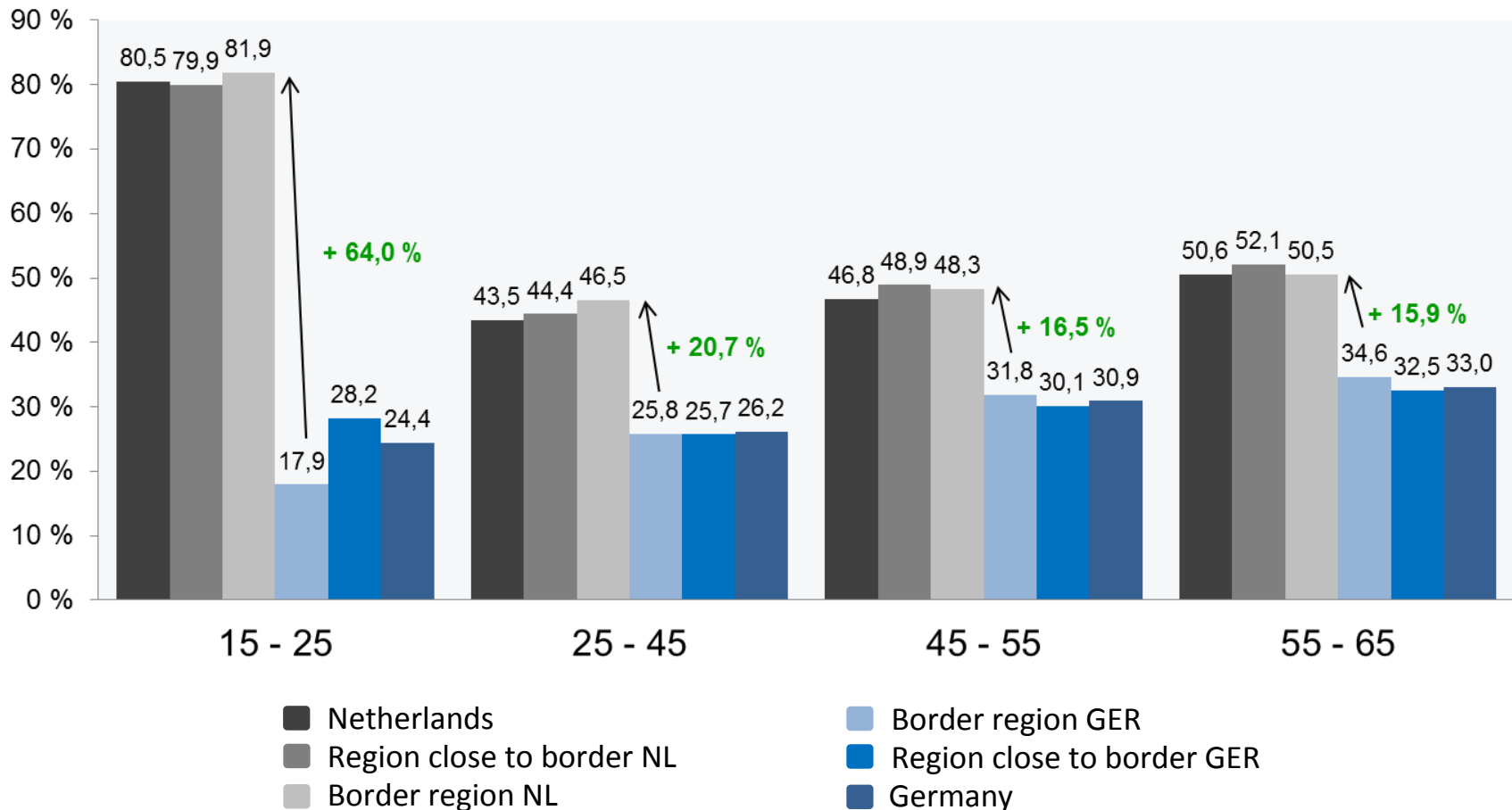
Part-time employment rate by sex

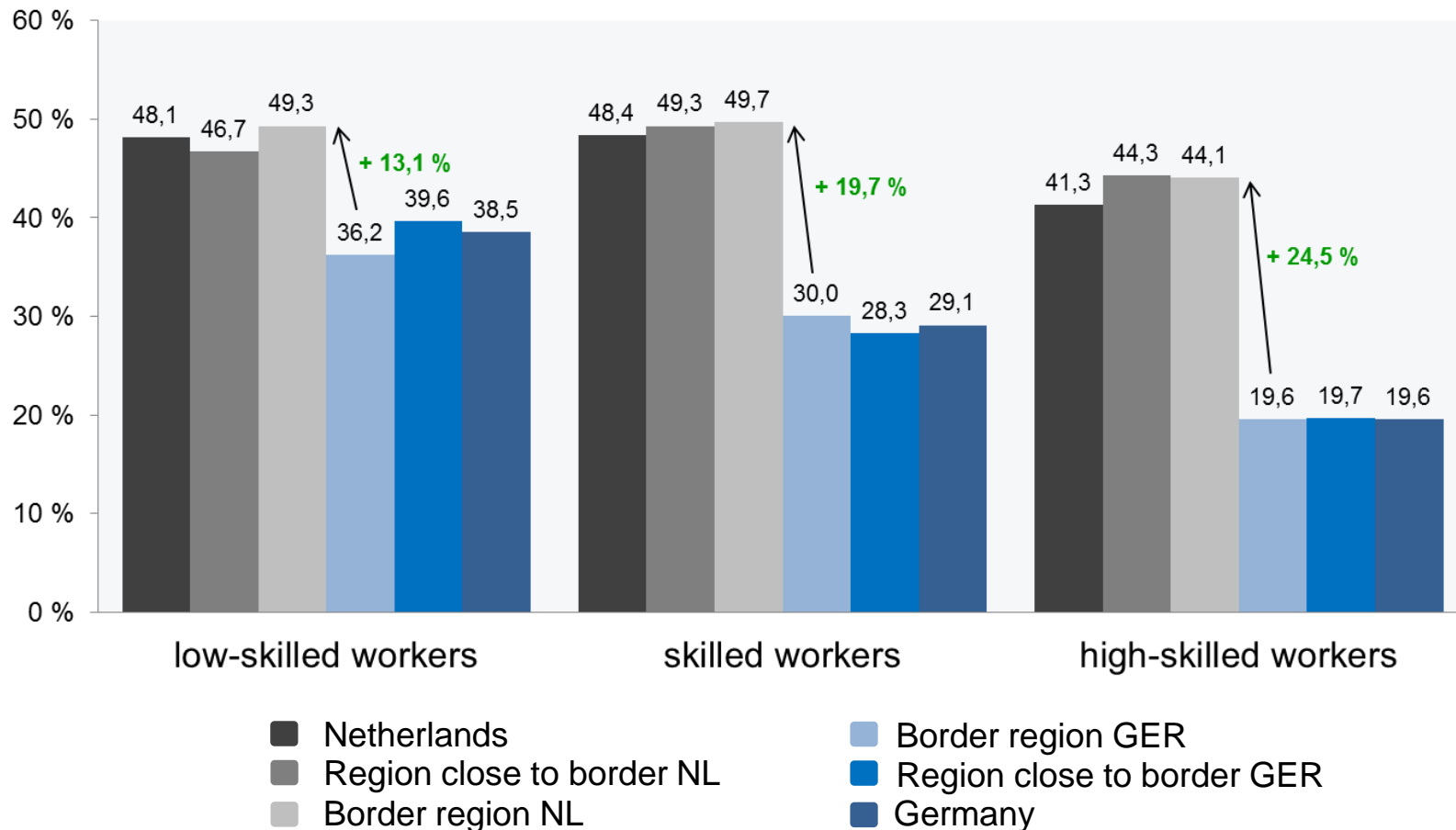
Part-time employment rate by age groups
